

Warwickshire Local History Society Outings 2012

Saturday 12th May, 2012. A walking tour of Kenilworth. Meet at 2.00 p.m. at St. Nicholas' car park, Abbey Fields accessed off Bridge Street (allow time for parking, it may be busy). We will walk from St. Nicholas' parish church to Castle Green, along High Street and Castle Hill, to include the Abbey ruins (but not the Castle), tea and cakes in the parish church. Lead by Richard Morris and Richard Storey with the help of Kenilworth History and Archaeology Society. Cost will be £13 for members and £15 for guests. *Numbers for this trip are strictly limited, so early applications are recommended.*

Saturday 16th June, 2012. A visit to Atherstone. Meet at 2 p.m. for a guided walk around the town which dates from Anglo-Saxon times, followed by afternoon tea which, if the weather is good will be in the garden of Mrs. Judy Vero's house which is Grendon Lodge built in 1828. Parking will be at Station House (the old railway station building) on Long Street. Cost will be £13 for members and £15 for guests.

Saturday 7th July, 2012. Annual summer social in Ilmington. Assemble at 5 p.m. outside the village hall or in Foxcote Road for us to begin our guided walk around this ancient and interesting village, the walk will include an opportunity to look at the garden of Ilmington Manor (by kind permission of Martin Taylor). Return to the village hall by 7 p.m. when we will be serving our usual sumptuous summer social supper.

N.B. There will be a prize awarded to the child (aged under 14) who can identify the most "mice" in the village church, so do bring along youngsters who will be expected to carry paper and pencil!

Cost will be £21 for members and £23 for guests – and £3 for children aged under 14

Saturday 22nd September 2012. A visit to Coventry. Either use the Ikea car park or the park and ride from the Memorial Park - stay on the bus after it has called at the main stop near Broadgate and alight at the Co-Operative Store in Corporation Street. St. John's Church where we assemble at 2 p.m. is then across the road. Dr. Nat Alcock will lead us first into St. John's Church followed by a visit to the Weaver's House returning to Spon Street where we will have tea at The Old Windmill Inn. Cost will be £15 for members and £17 for guests. N.B. NOT a Sunday as shewn on the programme card, apologies.
