The Fire of Warwick was a major conflagration that swept through Warwick on 5 September 1694 and lasted for six hours. The fire started when sparks from a lighted taper blew onto the thatched roof of one of the houses opposite the Lord Leycester Hospital. Follow the route of the fire with 'Unlocking Warwick' and WLHS member Sue Rigby. We will also be joined by WLHS member Steven Wallsgrove, who will tell us about some of the stories contained within contemporary documents of the time, and show some facsimiles (weather permitting).
