



# “Bagot’s Castle, Baginton”

Saturday 4th September 2021

We meet at 2 pm at Bagot’s castle, Church Road, Baginton, CV8 3AR (free car parking available). The Bagot’s Castle archaeologist will take us on a tour of this 14th century castle which now stands in ruins. The original building is believed to have been constructed on the site in the 11th century, at the time of King Henry I. It was rebuilt as the current castle in the late thirteen hundreds by Sir William Bagot, a distinguished nobleman of the time.

We will be walking on footpaths across grassy fields which are uneven and might be muddy. Access for scooters and wheelchairs is possible for the first, main, part of the tour, although you wouldn’t be able to get a wheelchair or scooter into the actual ruins. The path round the wider site is definitely NOT suitable for wheelchairs and scooters.
